

Dr. Christine Frison is a Post-Doctoral Affiliated Research Fellow at the Centre for Philosophy of Law (CPDR) from the Université catholique de Louvain (UCLouvain) and at Centre for IT & IP Law (CiTiP) from the KU Leuven. Starting April 2017 onwards, she will hold a Post-Doctoral Research Fellow position at the Law Faculty of the University of Antwerp (UAntwerp, Belgium). Her research interests include issues related to international law and governance of plant genetic resources for food and agriculture, biodiversity and biosafety. At UAntwerp, she will collaborate on the INDIGO project (<http://theindigoproject.be/>).

Christine holds a joint-PhD (UCLouvain and KU Leuven, Belgium, 2016), an LL.M. in Public International Law (Université Libre de Bruxelles – ULB, Belgium, 2004), an LL.M. in International and Trade Law (Université Lyon I, France, 2003), and an LL.B. (Université Montpellier I, France, 2002).

Since 2004, Christine is also a legal research fellow at the Centre for International Sustainable Development Law (CISDL, Montréal, McGill University). Between 2004 and 2011, she was a consultant for various international, governmental or non-governmental organizations (i.e. UNEP, Bioversity International, the Belgian Public Federal Services for the Environment, CISDL). In 2011, she co-edited a book on agrobiodiversity issues entitled “Plant Genetic Resources and Food Security: Stakeholder Perspectives on the International Treaty on Plant Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture” with Dr José T.
